



# NAVIGATING THE ROADMAP UNDER 14

- There are a total of 8 steps.
- Logged in students will be able to earn achievement badges at each step.
- Each step has a video that will play (user will be able to skip the video playback) in English and Spanish versions.



## Step 1 - Start Here

Helps you determine whether you're eligible for special assistance and services by walking through key questions about disabilities and linking you to detailed definitions and next steps.



## Step 2 - Support Documents

Provides access to essential documents like IEPs and 504 plans, so you can gather the paperwork needed to get specialized education services.



## Step 3 - Services for All

Outlines all the support and services available through Nevada TRIP for children under age 14, helping families understand early-stage eligibility, options, and next steps.



## Step 4 - Specialized Services

Details the specialized services available to children under 14 when their needs go beyond general support, guiding families through eligibility and how to access additional resources.



## Step 5 - Pre-Employment Services

Explains how you can use Pre-ETS to get ready for work after high school. It includes programs that practice social skills and build confidence.



## Stop 6 - Planning for High School

Offers guidance on how you and your family can plan for high school, covering academic choices, supports, goal setting, and preparation for the years ahead.



## Stop 7 - Complete Elementary or Middle School

Explains what to expect in high school. Your TRIP doesn't end here. After you turn 14, there is a whole other roadmap to explore.
