- 5 3:15 - 4:15 PM (ages 13+)

### Volunteer Opportunities

- Serve as a one-on-one “spotter” assisting participants in the water.
- Provide encouragement, support, and safety alongside professional instructors.
- Volunteers must be at least **15 years old.**
- Volunteers must be able to swim and be comfortable in a pool setting.

### Volunteer Commitment

- Volunteers are asked to commit to attending all five days of camp to provide consistency for participants.
- Sessions are one hour each day, plus a brief daily orientation and setup/cleanup time.
- A 2-hour training course Sunday prior to camp week.

### Training

- Volunteers must attend a mandatory orientation session on Sunday, June 21 at 3:00 PM at Moana Springs Aquatic Center.
- On-site instruction and supervision will be provided.
